

Now that you've installed iOS 7, some new settings will need to be fixed (and old settings that may need to be reset).

Upon completing the update, your iPad will reboot. After the start screen, you will be prompted to enter your passcode, or create one if you haven't already.

It is highly recommended that you create a passcode. It's important that it be easy to remember, but difficult to guess. We generally suggest **7630** – the last four digits of the Aisle7 Support phone number.

You can dismiss the message about Spotlight, then tap **Settings**.

Now go to each section in bold below, find the listed settings, and adjust them accordingly.

NOTE: In iOS 7, "Off" is indicated by a gray background when the switch is in the **left** position.
